1. What did David appoint Asaph and his brothers to do in 1 Chronicles 16:7?

To give thanks to the LORD, through a psalm of praise.

2. According to 1 Chronicles 16:8, what should be made known to the people?

God's deeds among the nations — His acts.

3. What does verse 11 encourage the people to seek continually?

The LORD and His strength; His face/presence.

4. How is God described in 1 Chronicles 16:25-27?

Great, greatly to be praised, above all gods, with honour, majesty, strength, and gladness in His presence.

5. Reflection: This psalm was written specifically to mark a moment of celebration. What's something in your own life worth pausing to celebrate with thanksgiving?
