Walking in the Light — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What message does John say he has heard from Jesus and declares in 1 John 1:5?

'God is light, and in him is no darkness at all.'

2. What claim does 1 John 1:6 warn against?

Claiming to have fellowship with God while walking in darkness — this is a lie, and not living the truth.

3. What happens 'if we walk in the light,' according to 1 John 1:7?

We have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus Christ cleanses us from all sin.

4. What promise is given in 1 John 1:9 to those who confess their sins?

God is faithful and just to forgive our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

5. Reflection: Is there anything you've been avoiding bringing honestly before God, trusting in the promise of 1 John 1:9?
