A Living Hope — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What has believers been given, according to 1 Peter 1:3, and through what?

A 'lively (living) hope,' through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

2. How is the believer's inheritance described in 1 Peter 1:4?

Incorruptible, undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven.

3. According to 1 Peter 1:6-7, what purpose can trials serve?

Testing/proving faith, which is more precious than gold, resulting in praise, honour, and glory at Christ's return.

4. How does Peter describe believers' love for Christ in 1 Peter 1:8, even though they have not seen Him?

They love Him, and believe in Him, rejoicing with joy unspeakable and full of glory.

5. Reflection: What does it mean to you to have hope that is described as 'living' rather than just wishful thinking?
