3. What is the famous warning in 1 Timothy 6:10?

'The love of money is the root of all evil' — leading some to stray from the faith and pierce themselves with sorrows.

4. What is Timothy instead urged to pursue and to do, in 1 Timothy 6:11-12?

To follow righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness, and to 'fight the good fight of faith,' laying hold on eternal life.

5. Reflection: What would 'contentment' genuinely look like in your own financial situation right now?
