Choose Life — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What choice does Moses set before the people in Deuteronomy 30:15?

Life and good, or death and evil.

2. What does obedience lead to, according to Deuteronomy 30:16?

Life, multiplication, and blessing in the land they were entering.

3. What warning is given in Deuteronomy 30:17-18 about turning away?

That turning to worship other gods would lead to their destruction, and they would not prolong their days in the land.

4. What is Moses' famous exhortation in Deuteronomy 30:19-20?

'Choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live... that thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and... cleave unto him.'

5. Reflection: Moses frames this decision as one of life and death. What 'choice' in your own life feels like it carries similar weight right now?

Open, personal reflection.
