

# Genesis — Worksheet 1: Answer Key

Creation & the Fall — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. According to Genesis 1, over how many days did God create the heavens and the earth, and what happened on the seventh day?

Six days of creation, followed by a seventh day of rest (Genesis 2:2-3).

## 2. What does it mean that humankind was made 'in the image of God' (Genesis 1:27)? Answer in your own words.

Accept answers touching on humans reflecting God's character, having value/dignity, and being given responsibility to steward creation.

## 3. What one instruction did God give Adam about the tree of the knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:16-17)?

He could eat freely from every tree except that one; eating from it would bring death.

## 4. How did the serpent tempt Eve, and what did she and Adam do (Genesis 3:1-6)?

The serpent questioned and twisted God's word, suggesting they would not die and would become like God; Eve ate the fruit and gave some to Adam, who also ate.

## 5. What consequences did God give to the serpent, the woman, and the man after the fall (Genesis 3:14-19)?

The serpent was cursed to crawl on its belly; the woman would have pain in childbirth; the man would toil for food from a cursed ground.

## 6. Even in judgement, what sign of God's continued care do we see in Genesis 3:21?

God made garments of skin for Adam and Eve and clothed them, rather than abandoning them.

## 7. Reflection: What does the creation story teach us about God's character and His relationship to the created world?

Open reflection — look for engagement with ideas like order, goodness, care, and relationship rather than a 'right' answer.
