

# Haggai — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

The Latter Glory of This House — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What does God promise to do, according to Haggai 2:6-7?

Shake the heavens, earth, sea, and dry land, and shake all nations — with the desire of all nations coming, filling the house with glory.

## 2. What does God claim ownership of in Haggai 2:8?

'The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.'

## 3. What comparison is made in Haggai 2:9 between the new Temple and the former one?

That the glory of this latter house would be greater than the former, and God would give peace in this place.

## 4. Reflection: The rebuilt Temple seemed smaller and less impressive than Solomon's original. What does this promise suggest about how God measures something's true worth?
