

# Joel — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

I Will Pour Out My Spirit — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What promise does God make in Joel 2:28?

To pour out His Spirit on all flesh, so that sons and daughters would prophesy, and old men dream dreams, young men see visions.

## 2. According to Joel 2:29, who else would receive the Spirit?

Servants and handmaids (male and female servants) — a promise not limited to any one social class.

## 3. What events are described in Joel 2:30-31?

Wonders in heaven and earth — blood, fire, pillars of smoke, the sun turned to darkness, and the moon to blood — before the great day of the LORD.

## 4. What promise is given in Joel 2:32?

'Whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered/saved.'

## 5. This passage is quoted by Peter in Acts 2 at Pentecost. Why do you think the early church saw that day as a fulfilment of Joel's promise?

Accept answers connecting the Spirit being poured out broadly (not on a select few) to what happened when the Holy Spirit came upon all the believers gathered.
