'I Am': Who Jesus Says He Is — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. How does John's Gospel describe Jesus in its opening verses (John 1:1-5)?

As 'the Word,' who was with God and was God, through whom all things were made, and who is light and life.

2. What does Jesus mean when He says, 'I am the bread of life' (John 6:35)?

That He satisfies spiritual hunger and gives life in a way physical food cannot.

3. What does Jesus mean when He says, 'I am the good shepherd' (John 10:11-14)?

That He knows and cares for His people personally, and is willing to lay down His life for them.

4. What did Jesus do for Lazarus, and what does this miracle show about Jesus (John 11:38-44)?

He raised Lazarus from the dead after four days in the tomb, showing His power over death.

5. Reflection: Of all the 'I am' statements Jesus makes in John's Gospel, which one means the most to you, and why?
