

John — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

The Last Supper & the Resurrection — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What did Jesus do for His disciples that surprised them at the Last Supper (John 13:3-5)?

He washed their feet, a task normally done by a servant.

2. What 'new commandment' does Jesus give His disciples (John 13:34-35)?

To love one another as He has loved them, so that all would know they are His disciples by their love.

3. Who was the first person to see the risen Jesus, and what did she initially think He was (John 20:11-15)?

Mary Magdalene; she initially thought He was the gardener.

4. Why is Thomas remembered as 'Doubting Thomas,' and what did Jesus say to him (John 20:24-29)?

He refused to believe Jesus had risen until he could see and touch His wounds; Jesus later invited him to do so, and said, 'blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.'

5. What reason does John give for writing his Gospel (John 20:30-31)?

That readers may believe Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and have life through His name.

6. Reflection: Thomas needed to see before he believed. What helps you believe, even when you can't see?
