Jonah Flees — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What does God tell Jonah to do in Jonah 1:1-2?

Go to Nineveh and cry out against its wickedness.

## 2. What does Jonah do instead, according to Jonah 1:3?

He flees in the opposite direction, boarding a ship toward Tarshish.

## 3. What happens once Jonah is at sea, according to Jonah 1:4?

The LORD sends a great wind and a mighty tempest, threatening to break the ship apart.

## 4. What happens to Jonah after he is thrown overboard, according to Jonah 1:17?

The LORD prepares a great fish to swallow him, and he is inside it for three days and three nights.

## 5. Reflection: Jonah tried to run from a task he didn't want. Have you ever tried to avoid something you sensed you were meant to do?
