

# Joshua — Worksheet 2: Answer Key

The Fall of Jericho & Choosing to Serve the Lord — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What unusual instructions did God give Israel for taking Jericho (Joshua 6:1-5)?

March around the city once a day for six days, and seven times on the seventh day, then have the priests blow trumpets while the people shout.

## 2. What happened to Jericho's walls when the people obeyed (Joshua 6:20)?

The walls fell down flat, and the people took the city.

## 3. At the end of his life, what challenge does Joshua give the people (Joshua 24:14-15)?

To fear the Lord and serve Him in sincerity and truth, choosing that day whom they would serve.

## 4. What is Joshua's own famous declaration in verse 15?

'As for me and my house, we will serve the LORD.'

## 5. Reflection: Joshua made a public, deliberate choice to serve God. What would it look like for you to make that same choice today?
