Keep Yourselves in God's Love — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What are believers told to build themselves up on, in Jude 1:20?

Their most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit.

## 2. What are they told to keep themselves in, according to Jude 1:21?

The love of God, while looking for the mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ leading to eternal life.

## 3. What does Jude 1:22-23 instruct regarding those who doubt or have fallen into error?

To have compassion on some, and to save others, pulling them out of the fire, while being cautious not to be corrupted themselves.

## 4. What is the well-known closing doxology in Jude 1:24-25?

Praise to the One who is able to keep us from falling, and present us faultless before His glory with exceeding joy — to the only wise God be glory, majesty, dominion, and power.

## 5. Reflection: Jude ends on a note of confidence in God's ability to keep believers steady. What does that promise mean to you personally?
