The Parables of Luke — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. In the Parable of the Good Samaritan, who passed by the wounded man without helping (Luke 10:31-32)?

A priest and a Levite.

2. What did the Samaritan do for the wounded man (Luke 10:33-35)?

He bandaged his wounds, took him to an inn, cared for him, and paid the innkeeper to look after him.

3. In the Parable of the Prodigal Son, what did the younger son do with his inheritance (Luke 15:11-13)?

He took his share and wasted it in 'riotous living' in a far country.

4. How did the father react when he saw his son returning home (Luke 15:20)?

He saw him a long way off, ran to him, and embraced and kissed him.

5. Why was the older brother upset, and how did the father respond to him (Luke 15:28-32)?

He felt his years of faithful service went unrewarded; the father assured him all he had was still his, and celebrated because his lost brother was found.

6. Reflection: Which character in the Prodigal Son do you relate to most right now — the younger son, the older son, or the father — and why?
