Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

1. What principle of justice is stated in Obadiah 1:15?

'As thou hast done, it shall be done unto thee: thy reward shall return upon thine own head.'

2. What does Obadiah 1:17 promise about Mount Zion?

That there will be deliverance there, and it will be holy.

3. What is the final declaration of the book in Obadiah 1:21?

That 'the kingdom shall be the LORD's' — God's rule established over all.

4. Reflection: Obadiah ends with confidence that God's justice and kingdom will ultimately prevail. Where do you find it hardest to trust that outcome in the world today?
