Christ's Humility — marking guide

Use this to mark your own worksheet. For reflection questions, there is no single right answer — check that your response genuinely engages with the passage.

## 1. What attitude does Paul encourage in Philippians 2:3-4?

Doing nothing through selfish ambition, but in humility considering others better than ourselves, and looking to others' interests as well as our own.

## 2. What did Christ give up, according to Philippians 2:6-7?

Though equal with God, He made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a servant.

## 3. How far did Christ's humility go, according to Philippians 2:8?

To death, even death on a cross.

## 4. What does God do in response, according to Philippians 2:9-11?

Highly exalts Him and gives Him a name above every name, so every knee will bow and every tongue confess Jesus Christ is Lord.

## 5. Reflection: This passage is sometimes called the model of humility. What would 'considering others better than yourself' look like in one relationship in your life this week?
